Register a foal

It is a legal requirement to register your foal within 6 months of birth or before 31 December in the year of birth, whichever is the later. On completion of the Registration form, you will automatically receive a unique reference number for your pony. *Please submit the **Passport Registration Form and Silhouette Form**.*

The information on the form will then be entered in our society purebred Studbook and you will receive a laminated copy of the Registration Certificate for your own use.

Basic requirement:- Sire & Dam in studbook (or genetic proof of status)

Details required:- Sire, Dam, DOB,, Place of Birth, Breeders Details, Name of Pony, Sex, Owners Details and Keepers details.

The cost of the certificate is £5 however this is free of charge when submitted with a Passport Application.

NEW PASSPORT APPLICATION

Every equine (horse, pony, donkey) over 6 months of birth or before 31 December in the year of birth, whichever is the later MUST by LAW have a horse passport.

We will be pleased to supply you with an identity passport for equines whose breeding cannot be verified so long as the following are carried out:

- A silhouette must be completed by your veterinary surgeon who will examine your equine to see if a microchip is present. If no microchip is found then he must implant a chip of the approved standard. Only silhouettes provided by us are acceptable and can be obtained by emailing us. We cannot accept silhouettes provided by other PIO's. If your vet has implanted a new microchip, please obtain the bar codes from him/her and send them to us together with completed paperwork. If a microchip is found, then we will endeavour to ascertain if the horse had been previously issued with a passport by another PIO. If we find that it has, then we cannot issue your horse with a passport and you will have to obtain a duplicate from the original PIO.
- The horse/pony/cob/donkey must not be eligible for registration in the purebred with verified breeding studbook of a breed society.

Remember, the silhouette must be completed by a veterinarian using our official forms which can be obtained by this website or contacting the Society.
